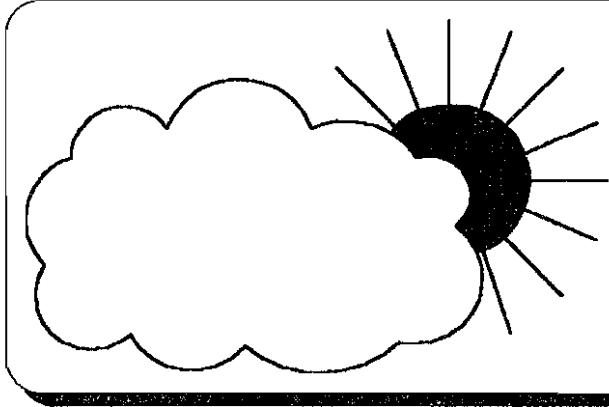

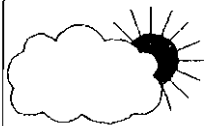

Mustering out service set for Fitzsimons Saturday

AURORA — The public is invited to come and say goodbye to Fitzsimons Army Medical Center Saturday.

After nearly 78 years of providing medical care to wounded soldiers, retirees, active-duty personnel and their family members, the post will formally close as a medical center.

Emergency services and inpatient care will continue until the end of June. After that, the hospital will be reduced to a medical clinic.

A closing ceremony will begin at 9 a.m. on the parade field in front of the hospital.

Brig. Gen. John Parker will relinquish command of the post to Col. John Bull, a medical service corps officer and deputy chief of staff for readiness operation.

Bull will command the U.S. Army Garrison, Fitzsimons. The garrison will be the "housekeeper" of the installation until its final closure, said spokeswoman Helen Littlejohn. The garrison will be responsible for support functions.

Saturday ceremonies will include graduating the last class of the medical education program, which back to World War I, when the Army established the hospital.

 - **July 1** — Outpatient clinic opens on second and third floors of the main hospital. Clinic will be staffed by 10 doctors, including two pediatricians. Radiology, pathology, optometry and pharmacy services will be offered.
 - Active-duty personnel, retirees and family members may use the clinic. Patient appointments may be made beginning June 15. The clinic will be open from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. Routine appointment number is 739-2500.
 - **Spring 1997** — TriCare begins and clinic will close. TriCare is a health maintenance organization for the Department of Defense. Active-duty personnel, dependents and retirees under 65 are eligible.
 - **1998** — Commissary and post exchange store expected to close, depending on economic conditions.
 - **1999-2001** — Army closes the post.

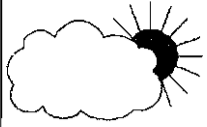

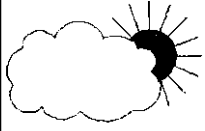
