Roger Braley passed away after a long illness as did Joe Hallack's wife Marge. There are no services for Marge but you can donate to any Hospise.

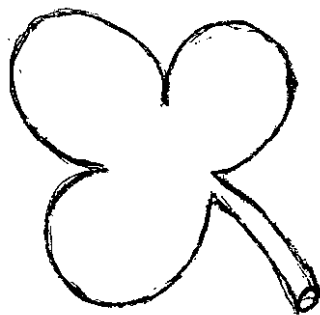
Mississippi gate is now open 0500 to 1700 M thru F.

Split health-care ruling for vets

PIENSACOLA, Fla. — Military retirees over age 65 who enlisted before a 1966 law may sue the government for breaking its promise of free health care for life, a federal judge ruled Wednesday.

But U.S. District Judge Roger Vinson also limited the claims to \$10,000 per plaintiff and ruled that those who entered the service after the law was enacted may not sue.

The 1966 law allows for treatment of retirees at military medical facilities only on a space-available basis, but recruiters continued making promises into the 1980s of free lifetime health care without mentioning the restriction. (AP)


Great turnout, 107 were present to wish Spike and Hanna their best wishes.

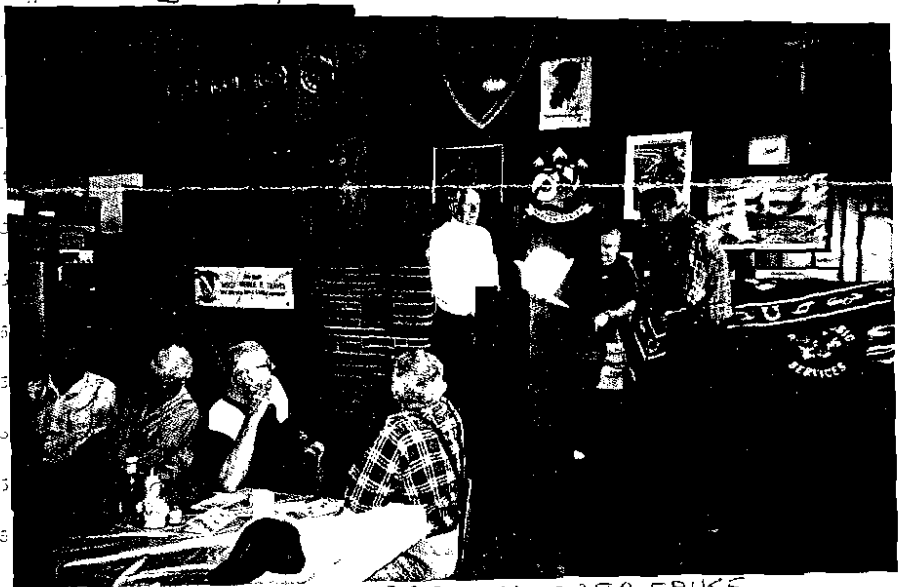
