1st Lt Arthur Ecklund's remains were interned in Galesburg, IL. (His jaw bone had been found in the Philippines.) DNA results showed more of Ecklund's remains were discovered with Major Perry Jefferson's and could not be separated, hence the joint services.

1 April, 1800-2000, Ecklund and Jefferson "Viewing" at local Robert J. Murphy Funeral Home. (Speculation is that both caskets will be closed.)

2 April, 1045, Ecklund Memorial Service, Old Post Chapel, Ft Meyer. (Both caskets will be present.) Ecklund Caisson and Interment with Full Honors (by Army) to follow service.

3 April, 1245, Memorial Service for Perry Jefferson, presided by Chaplain Hoops, Old Post Chapel, Ft

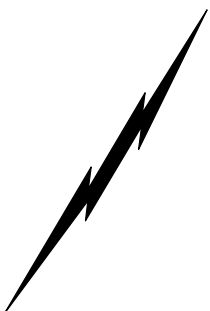
