# HOWDY DUTY BY JOE BROOM

Colonel Philip Packer, Commander of the 140th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron in 1955, gave me this story.

The Colorado Air National Guard got a call for some airlift support for a baby in Montrose, Colorado. She was born early and needed some help with a health issue. They were told that there would be somebody at the community airport with the baby. She was in need of incubation and was put on the COANG "Goony Bird"(C-47) to get her to Children's Hospital in Denver. When the aircraft got to Montrose, they found the airport had a very small shack for building. They landed and taxied over to this shack and realized that nobody was there. They shut down the aircraft and waited an hour or so.

While they were waiting, they spotted a pickup truck bouncing across the field. It pulled up next to the airplane and a guy with a cowboy hat and boots got out of the truck with the baby in his arms. He was the local Doctor. They got the baby on board he aircraft and used an incubator to stabilize her.

They landed at Buckley and transported the baby to Children's Hospital in Denver without any problems.

Sometime later he met the teenage girl and she was doing great.

The COANG have included many transport aircraft including the C-54, C-131, T-43 and the C-47 noted in this story.

This is one of many stories of how the COANG has assisted the Colorado Community when other means of help were not available.
